Notre Dame Housing (NDH) has provided affordable housing coupled with supportive services to Omaha's population of low-to-moderate income seniors for 25 years.

Based in North Omaha, we envision creating a community that provides older adults with the resources to maintain a safe, comfortable, and self-sufficient lifestyle.

We currently provide housing to 125 seniors in 107 units as well as education and programming for the local senior population at our campus. Our programming is offered to all seniors, not just residents, and our food pantry serves absolutely anyone.
